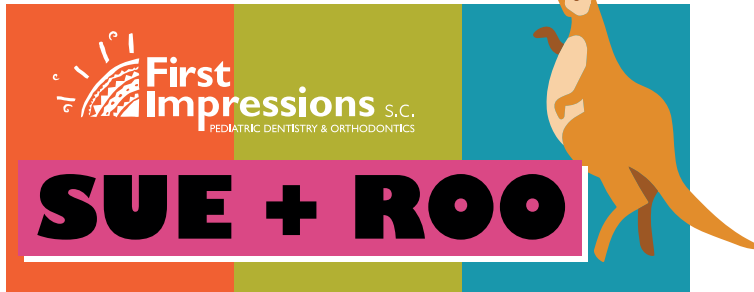


# FEBRUARY IS NATIONAL CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH MONTH



## DENTAL MATH

### ANSWERS

1. Calvin brushes his teeth three times a day with fluoride toothpaste. If he brushes seven days in a row, how many times will Calvin brush his teeth?

$$3 \times 7 = 21$$

Calvin brushed his teeth 21 times.



2. Teagan lost two teeth at age six, three teeth at age seven, three teeth at age eight, and four teeth at age nine. How many teeth has Teagan lost?

$$2 + 3 + 3 + 4 = 12$$

Teagan has lost 12 teeth.



3. Dad bought four packs of dental floss. Each pack holds six yards of dental floss. One yard equals three feet. How many feet of dental floss did dad buy?

$$4 \times 6 \times 3 = 72$$

Dad bought 72 feet of dental floss.



4. Willa, Holden, Violet, and Henry each go to the dentist two times a year. How many visits to the dentist does that make?

$$4 \times 2 = 8$$

Altogether, they went to the dentist 8 times.



5. Milk is good for your teeth. Emma drinks four glasses of milk each day. How many glasses of milk does Emma drink in seven days?

$$4 \times 7 = 28$$

Emma drinks 28 glasses of milk in seven days.
