



FEBRUARY IS NATIONAL AND CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH MONTH



CLEAN THE TEETH!

This is a great sensory project for younger kids to learn how to create (and clean, of course!) a messy mouth.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Gallon sized zip-seal bag or clear page cover Clear shampoo, hair gel, or aloe gel, etc. Old toothbrush Crayons, markers, or colored pencils

Masking tape

Tiny trinkets like beads, mini pom-poms, googly eyes, sequins, etc.

STEPS:

- 1. Download the coloring sheet and ask your little helpers to color the page.
- **2.** Align the coloring sheet with the transparency cover. Tape the corners of the coloring sheet to the **outside** of the transparency cover.
- **3.** With your transparency now taped on top of the coloring page, trace over the mouth and teeth with a dark permanent marker.
- **4.** Add a scoop of clear hair gel, shampoo, or shaving cream any thick, viscous liquid will do inside of the transparency bag.
- **5.** Create a messy mouth by adding little beads, pom-poms, googly eyes, or other small trinkets you find around the house
- **6.** Enclose the opening of the transparency using tape, and then secure the project to a flat surface by taping the corners down.
- **7.** Instruct your little helpers to use an old toothbrush to brush away the trinkets and gel, creating a nice and clean smile!

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
